1. To be valid, this form must be received not less than two clear days before the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting, i.e. by no later than by Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2025. It should be delivered to the Society Secretary, Mr S M Freestone by hand or by post at 47 Salisbury Street, Gainsborough DN21 2RS. Alternatively, the form can be printed, signed, scanned and sent by email to [media@redimptrust.co.uk](mailto:media@redimptrust.co.uk).
2. You must sign this form. If someone else signs the form on your behalf, you or that person must send the power of attorney or other written authority under which it is signed to the above address.
3. This form enables you to instruct your proxy how to vote on the resolutions to be proposed at the meeting and in the elections to be conducted at the meeting. Please indicate with an "X" how you wish your proxy to vote. Your proxy must vote in the way that you indicate. Please note that, if you do not give an instruction, your proxy may vote or abstain from voting as he or she thinks fit. Your proxy may also vote as he or she wishes on any other business which may properly come before the meeting, such as a resolution to adjourn the meeting.
4. A proxy need not be a member of the Society, but must attend the meeting electronically. No person other than the Chair of the Annual General Meeting can act as proxy for more than three members. The appointment of the Chair as proxy has been included for convenience. If you wish to appoint any other person as your proxy, please insert their details where appropriate and they will then be sent a Zoom link for the meeting, so that they can attend, speak and vote on your behalf: the Chair will not be entitled to vote on your behalf in such circumstances.
5. Returning the proxy form will not prevent you from attending the meeting and voting, but your proxy will not also be able to vote on your behalf in such circumstances.
6. The "Abstain" option is provided to enable you to abstain from voting on any particular resolution. However, an abstention is not a vote in law and will not be counted in the calculation of the proportion of the votes 'For' or 'Against' a resolution.
